1.	Can you identify the shape at the bottom right-hand corner of this Board?	Toll House
2.	What is the name of the animal doctor across the road from the Health Centre?	Jackson Vets (until the name changes!)
3	Now - we cross Station Road. Where are the trains?	Killearn Station was at the bottom of Station Road. There used to be a railway along the Blane Valley – where the West Highland Way is now.
4	What is the date on the gates of the village hall?	1953

5	Can you identify the shape at the bottom right-hand corner of this Board?	Kirk
6	How many clocks can you see from here?	2 (on the Kirk)
7	Where does the A875 road go to?	Glasgow and Balfron
8	What is the monument across the road?	War memorial. The names of people from the village who died in World Wars One and Two are carved on the memorial.

9	Can you identify the shape at the bottom right-hand corner of this Board?	Buchanan Monument
10	When was George Buchanan born?	1506
11	What fuel was sold from the building (now a house) across the road from the Buchanan Monument?	Petrol. The building used to be a garage. Before that it was a building for keeping coaches in.

12	Can you identify the shape at the bottom right-hand corner of this Board?	Old Kirk
13	Can you see a little Buchanan Monument in the graveyard?	
14	Beyond the Primary School the footpath on the way to the Cowfield used to be called Skittery Lane? Why?	Cows came down here to graze so there was cow poo on the path!

15	Roads here are named after trees. What tree names can you see on the Heritage Trail map – and as you walk up towards Main Street? (Can you find 7?)	Maple; Rowan; Birch; Beech; Cedar; Elder; Alder

17	There is a big board by the first entrance to the Glen. What bird is on the picture? What animal is on the picture?	Robin. Deer
